## Participation of the ENIC Ukraine to the SCAN-D 2 PROJECT

The main goal of the SCAN-D project is to foster knowledge of different Higher Education degrees in order to promote a better and fair recognition.

The purpose of the project is to collect samples of national degree certificates from Higher Education Institutions of the 24 participating countries: Armenia, Austria, Belarus, Belgium-Flemish Community, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, France, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, The Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Spain and, of course, Ukraine.

Financed by the European Commission in the framework of the Erasmus+ Programme - Action 3 (Support for Policy Reform), the SCAN-D 2 project started in April 2016 and will end in September 2017.

The ENIC Ukraine uploaded 275 samples of degree certificates in the SCAN-D database, giving a valuable contribution to the project and making a significant effort in promoting the recognition of Ukrainian qualifications abroad.
